## Committees have begun their work

The various committees have begun their work with the goal of having our application for affiliation ready by the end of August so it can be considered by Habitat International in the fall.

Most of the activity during the next few months will be carried out by the committees, and at this point all committees have planned at least their second meeting to continue work on their part of the application. The application process requires that we lay the foundation for the organization, answering many of the questions about how we will proceed before we get so far as to cause problems.
