Interlaken home proceeding quickly

Volunteers returned to the home on Lakeview Street in Interlaken during March and since then have been making rapid progress on the house.

A large group of volunteers from the churches in Trumansburg made a major contribution on April 17. The teenagers, accompanied by many adults from the parish, worked to build the front and rear porches for the home but concentrated their efforts on removing brush from the site and moving some of the soil which has been brought to the site into position.

On other days work has concentrated on the inside, as the drywall has been hung and finished and work continues on the plumbing in the basement.

On May 15 the storage shed, built last spring in the front yard as a temporary measure, was moved into its permanent location on the side of the property.

Painting work then took over at the site, to be followed by the installation of kitchen cabinets,

bathroom and kitchen fixtures.

The dedication ceremony June 5 will not be the end of the project, although it's hoped that not too many more weeks of work will be necessary.
